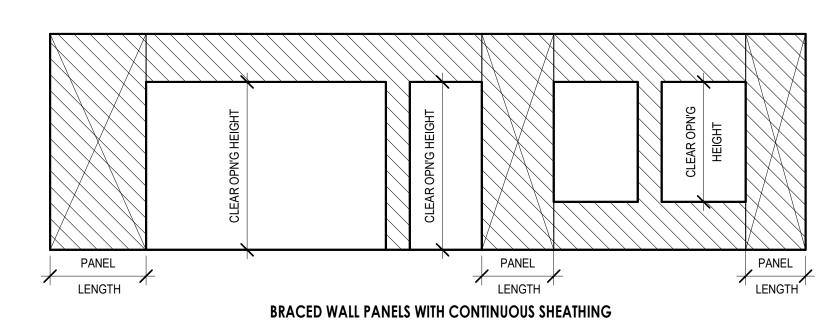
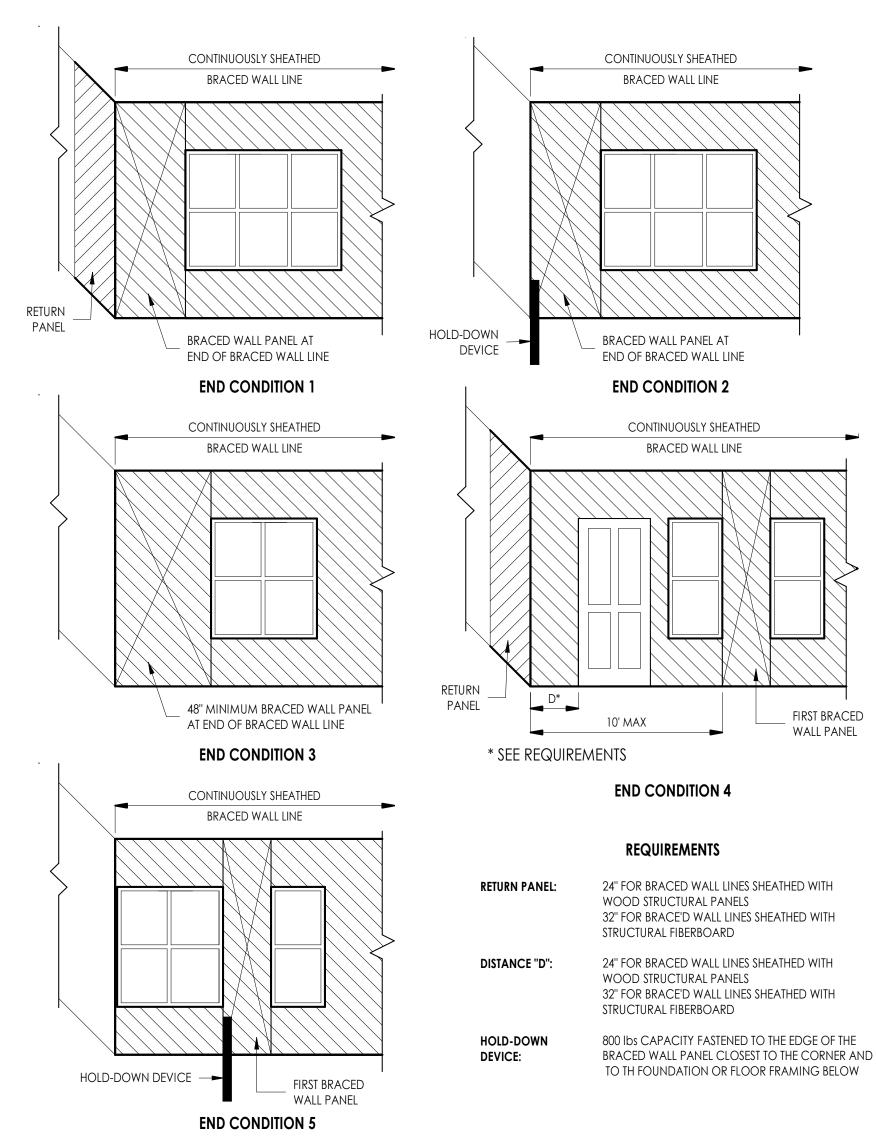
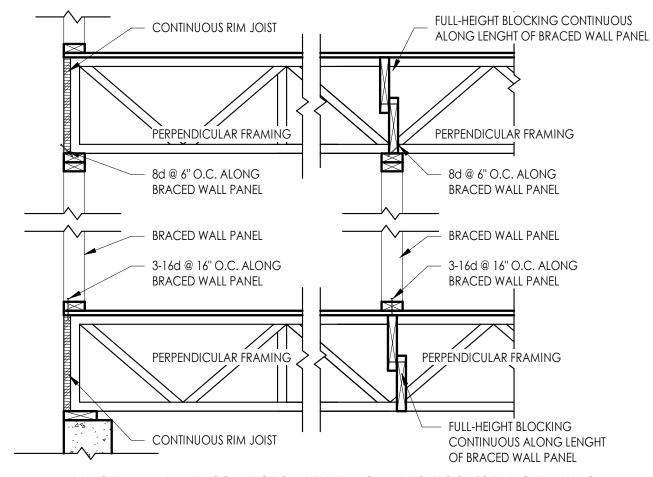


FIGURE R602.10.5 R602.10.5 BRACED WALL PANELS CONT SHEATHING



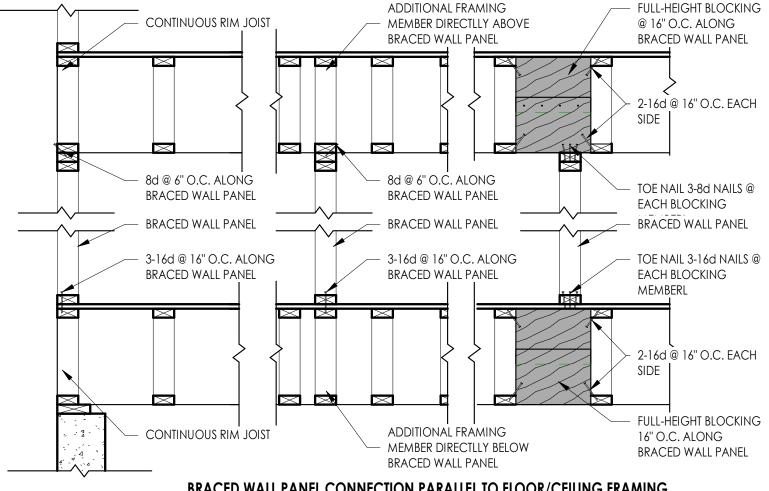

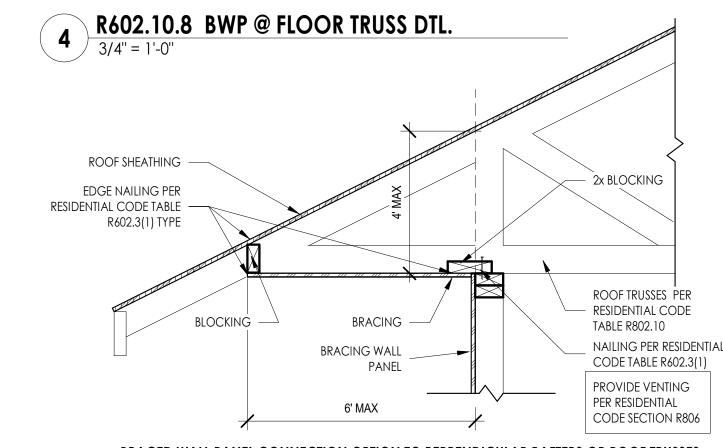


BRACED WALL PANEL CONNECTION PERPENDICULAR TO FLOOR/CEILING FRAMING

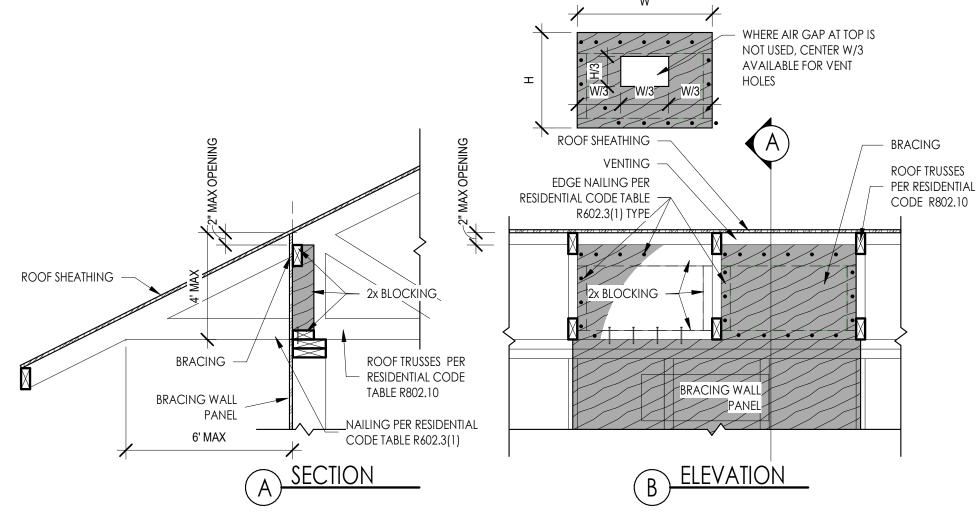
R602.10.8 BWP @ FLOOR TRUSS DETAIL



BRACED WALL PANEL CONNECTION PARALLEL TO FLOOR/CEILING FRAMING

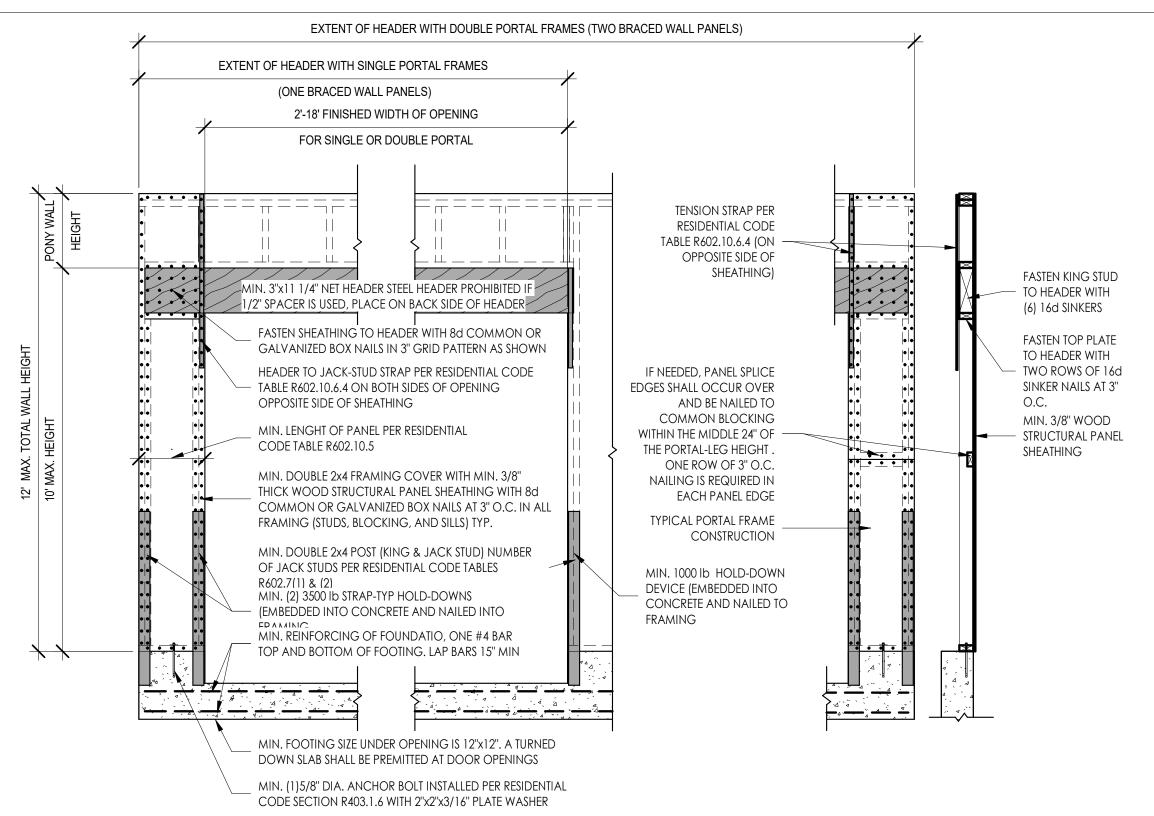
