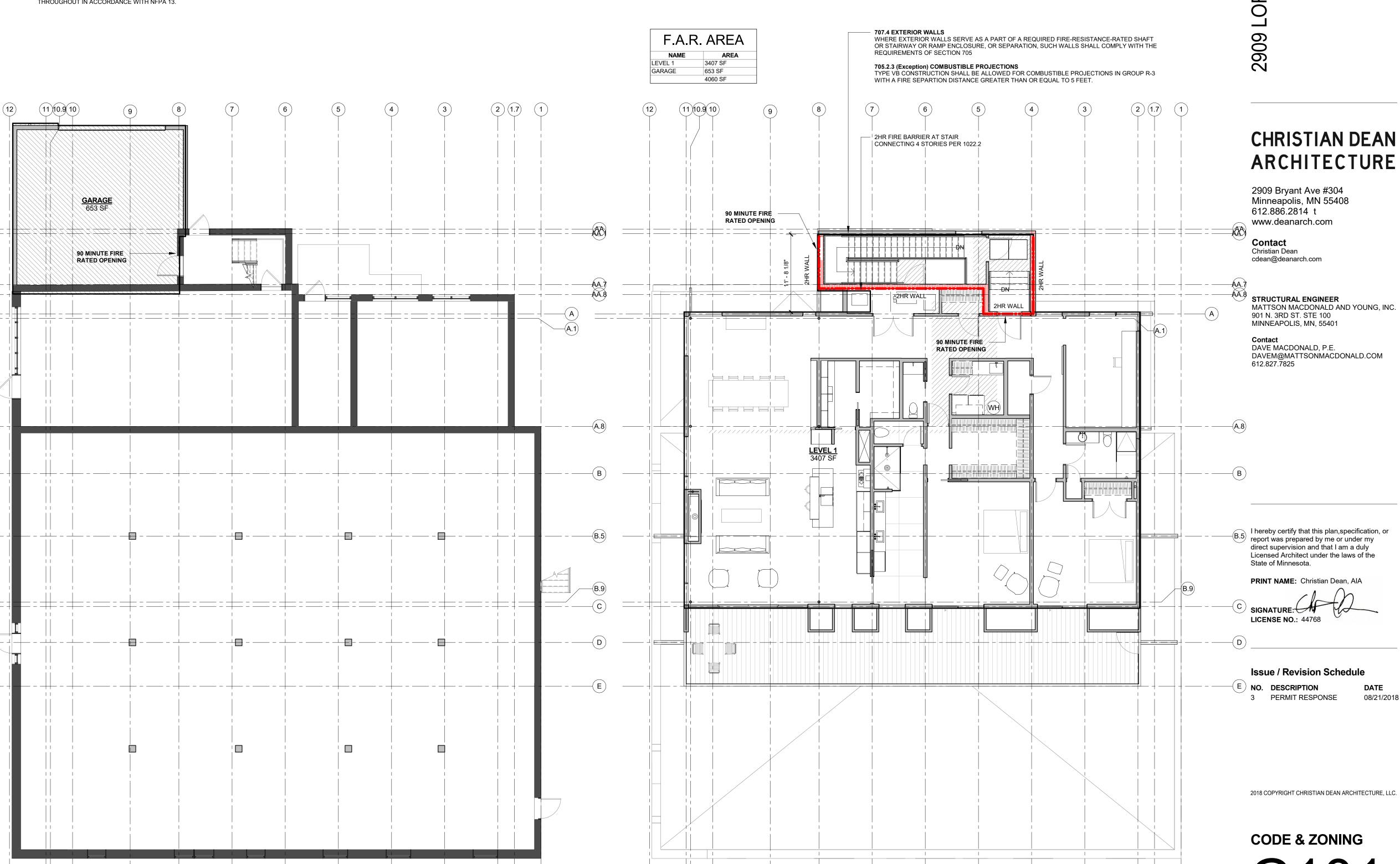

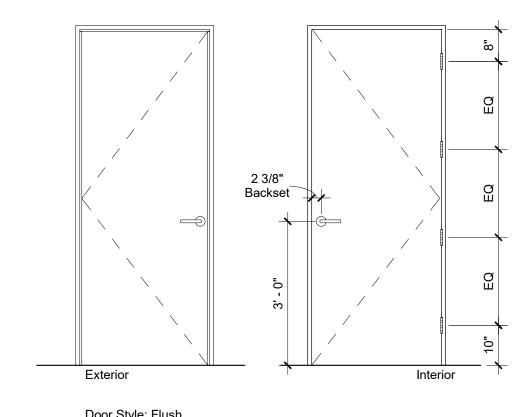

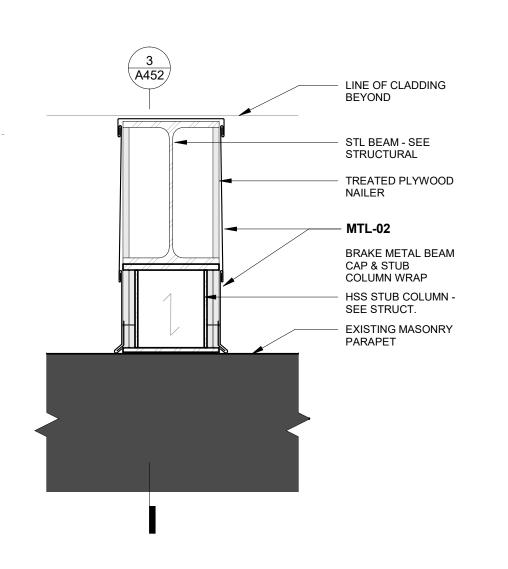


2 DETAIL - BEAM CAP & COLUMN WRAP ELEVATION



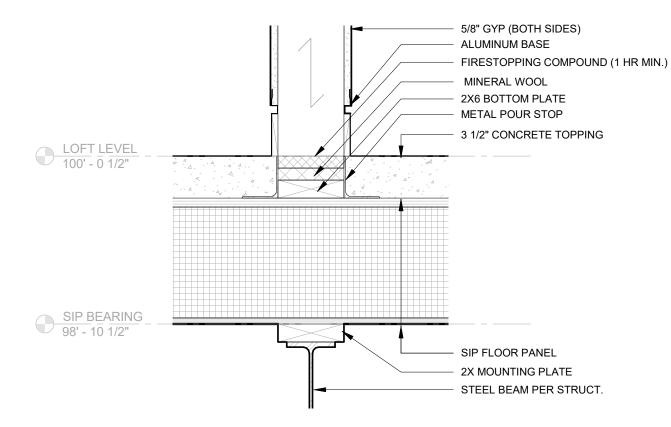

GENERAL NOTES

The contractor is solely responsible for site safety including all temporary precautionary measures and safety programs. Site observation visits by the SER do not include review of the contractor's safety precautions.

SUBMITTALS

Submit all submittals for all materials and/or products in a given system at one time. The contractor shall review and stamp all submittals prior to the SER's review. Stamp will include: Signature or initials certifying that all materials and/or products are in accordance with the requirements of the design documents.

Allow ten (10) business days for review and response for each submittal for review excluding delivery time to and from the Contractor. When revised for resubmission, identify all changes made since previous submission.

Submittals not requested will not be recognized or processed. All engineering design and associated calculations provided by others and submitted to the SER for review must bear a certification stamp and signature of a qualified professional engineer who is licensed in the state where the project is located.

The following items are to be issued as deferred submittals per 2015 Minnesota State Building Code Section 1300.0130: Prefabricated wood roof trusses

Steel connections Steel stairs

Structural insulated panels (SIPS) All items issued as deferred submittals are to be issued a minimum of 30 days prior to installation and must not be installed until their design and submittal documents have been reviewed for general conformance to the drawings by the general contractor, the SER and the building official. A copy of the deferred submittal must be forwarded to the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) after the SER has reviewed the documents and prior to the erection of the deferred submittal items. Deferred submittal items must not be installed until approved by the AHJ.

COORDINATION - ARCHITECTURAL, CIVIL, MECHANICAL, AND ELECTRICAL ITEMS

reference to architectural, civil, electrical, and mechanical drawings.

Contractor shall verify all dimensions and conditions on site with the plans before construction begins. All discrepancies must be reported immediately. Location, dimensions and details of recesses, depressions, openings, and equipment supports must be verified by

EXISTING CONDITIONS

Contractor shall verify all dimensions, elevations, and details of the existing structure where they affect the new structural work. Notify architect and SER if there are any deviations from the contract documents. Contractor shall field verify dimensions and elevations prior to fabrication of structural members.

Remove and replace existing architectural, electrical, mechanical, structural, civil, or miscellaneous items as necessary.

SHORING

General Contractor shall be responsible for temporary shoring of the existing construction until the new construction is in place and properly anchored in final form. Shoring loads for existing structure not shown in documents to be determined by an engineer licensed in the state in

which the project is located. Shoring must be designed and the final design must be submitted to SER per Submittal Section for review.

TEMPORARY BRACING

All structural members are designed for in-place loads. Contractor is responsible for bracing, without overstressing, all structural elements as required at all stages of construction until completion of this project. Provide temporary lateral support for all walls until adequately braced by the permanent structure. Provide required temporary bracing for structural steel until permanent bracing and walls are in place.

GENERAL SOIL NOTES

The structure has been designed using an assumed allowable soil bearing pressure of 2000 psf on virgin soil or compacted granular fill for footings. A qualified geotechnical engineer shall confirm the assumed allowable soil bearing pressure in a geotechnical report, and the site must be prepared in accordance. Any discrepancies in the assumed allowable soil bearing pressure must be reported immediately. If verified conditions differ from assumed capacities, redesign of the foundation system, size and reinforcing of footings, walls and retaining walls may be required.

Remove all top soil, un-compacted fill, and other poor soil from the construction site as determined by the geotechnical engineer. Slope the site to drain away from the building. The contractor shall verify the location of existing underground utilities, tanks and other obstacles prior to beginning

excavation. **FOOTINGS**

Footings are to be formed cast-in-place concrete.

Wall footings to be 12" deep with a minimum projection of 4" each side reinforced with 2-#5 continuous bottom bars. Pad footings to be a minimum of 2'-6" square by 12" deep reinforced with 3-#5 bottom bars each way. Wall footings are centered under walls and pad footings under columns or piers. Provide 30 bar diameter lap at splices and full crossing lap at corners and intersections.

Footing elevations shown on plan are to the top of the footing. Maintain minimum frost depth for all exterior footings. Frost depth is 42" typically and 60" at isolated, unheated spaces. Frost depth is measured from finished grade to the bottom of the footing.

Where the wall footing elevation changes, step the footing two units horizontal to one unit vertical. Footing reinforcing

must be continuous through footing steps. Cast dowels in footing for foundation walls, piers and columns above.

Dowels are to be the same size, and spacing as the vertical reinforcing of the wall, pier or column. Dowels must extend to 3" clear of bottom of footing. Refer to details for hooked dowels where needed.

CONCRETE

Provide ready-mixed concrete per ASTM C94. Portland cement must be ASTM C150, Type I. Use only one brand of cement throughout the work. Provide concrete aggregates meeting the requirements of ASTM C33. Water must be clean, free of deleterious amounts of acids, alkalis, or organic materials, and be considered potable. Provide admixtures to reduce water content, provide air-entrainment, or alter the quality of the concrete to meet the job conditions. Admixtures must be indicated in the mix designs.

All concrete exposed to weather, freeze-thaw conditions or de-icing chemicals shall contain 5% - 7% entrained air. Slump at point of discharge shall be as follows: Footings

Slabs on grade 3" - 4"

Masonry grout 8" - 11" Verify slump on site matches slump specified in the approved mix design by testing methods listed in ASTM C143. Workability of the concrete must be maintained so that concrete will completely fill forms without voids and bond to reinforcing without separation of materials.

Mix and deliver concrete in accordance with ASTM C94. Cooled or heated water must be used in accordance with ACI 305 and 306. Ready mixed concrete must be transported to the site in watertight agitators or mixer trucks loaded not in excess of rated capacities. Discharge at the site must be within one hour after charging. Air-entraining and chemical admixtures, if approved, must be charged into mixer as a solution as recommended by the manufacturer. Concrete placed during cold weather must conform to the requirements of ACI 306.1. For hot weather conditions, apply

recommendations of ACI 305. Place concrete in accordance with ACI 304 "Guide for Measuring, Mixing, Transporting, and Placing Concrete". Use mechanical vibrating equipment for consolidation. Do not use vibrators to transport concrete in forms.

Protect fresh concrete from premature drying and excessively hot or cold temperatures while maintaining minimal moisture loss at a relatively constant temperature above 55 degrees Fahrenheit. Provide wire, plastic, or precast concrete spacers, chairs, slab bolsters, support bars, etc. for support of reinforcing steel in

CONCRETE SLABS

All slabs on grade to be 4" thick and reinforced with 1.5 pounds per cubic yard polypropylene macro fiber. All concrete stairs cast on grade are to be a minimum of 6" thick and reinforced with #4 at 12" OC, each way, with 3" cover

Construction and/or control joints should occur at a maximum of 10'-0" OC at exterior slabs on grade, and at a maximum of 16'-0" OC at interior slabs on grade.

Construction and/or control joints should be laid out in a rectangular pattern with long to short side ratio less than or equal to 1.5 and with no re-entrant corners. Control joints for slabs on grade should be saw-cut as soon as concrete can accept it without raveling.

Do not cut control joints in structural slabs or topping slabs unless specifically directed. All control/construction joints must be continuous and not staggered or offset.

proper position while placing concrete. Chairs/bolsters must be stable and resist tipping.

CONCRETE TOPPING

All topping slabs must be reinforced with 1.5 pounds per cubic yard polypropylene macro fiber.

CONCRETE COVER ON REINFORCING

3" clear, bottom and sides Slabs on Metal Deck Center reinforcing in portion of slab above metal deck

Control joints must be cleaned and sealed for curing purposes as soon as possible.

Verify floor finishes and control/construction joint locations with owner and architect.

REINFORCED CONCRETE MASONRY WALLS

Hollow unit concrete masonry must be per ASTM C90. Mortar must be per ASTM C270: Type S for below grade and exterior masonry; Type N for all interior above grade masonry. All masonry units must be placed in running bond. Provide special shapes for jambs, columns, pilasters, control joints, corners and lintels.

See plans for location and spacing of reinforcement in walls. Locate reinforcement in cores with positioners.

Place at least (1) vertical reinforcing bar in wall corners.

When one bar is in a single core, place in center. When two bars are in a single core, place one near each face and refer to grout clearance requirements. For #6 and smaller, vertical steel must be continuous with 48 diameter lap at all splices for reinforcement in center of wall, 72 diameter lap at all splices for reinforcement near face of wall or as scheduled for specific conditions.

Fill masonry core at vertical columns with grout vibrated in place. Grout must be per ASTM C476 with a slump of 8" - 11" and tested per ASTM C143.

Wall heights must not exceed 5'-4" before placement of core grout unless cleanout holes are provided at the bottom of each maximum 5'-4" grout lift.

Provide ladder or truss style horizontal joint reinforcing, fabricated with galvanized minimum 9-gauge wire, placed every 2nd course (16" OC) in single wythe masonry walls. Provide bond beam with 2 - #5 at all floor lines, roof lines and top of walls or as specified on drawings.

Provide corner bars with 2'-0" legs for each horizontal bar in all bond beams at corners and intersecting walls. Provide full mortar bedded face shells and webs around all grouted cells for full bearing and to prevent leakage into adjacent cells.

Place control joints in the masonry walls such that no straight run of wall exceeds the lesser of 32 feet or 2.5 times the

Locate control joints at least 4'-0" from masonry wall pilasters and corners.

Bond beam reinforcing must be continuous through control joints. See architectural plans for location and detail of wall control joints.

Extend all lintels a minimum of 8" beyond opening and grout jamb core full height with 1 - #5 vertical reinforcing bar. At steel lintels, field weld 5/8" x 24" vertical threaded rod or #5 x 24" weldable rebar to top flange matching vertical reinforcing placement.

MASONRY VENEER

Masonry veneer is assumed to be a single 4" nominal wythe.

Anchor veneer to masonry backup with loop-and-pintle ties integrated with horizontal joint reinforcing at 16" OC

Anchor veneer to wood or cold formed steel stud backup framing with adjustable pintle-type anchors for every 2.67 square feet of veneer (16" OC vertically and 24" OC horizontally maximum). Place and install masonry brick wall ties as described in chapter 21 of the IBC for masonry and stud back up walls.

Place control joints in masonry veneer such that no straight run of wall exceeds the lesser of 25 feet or 1.5 times the Locate control joints at least 4'-0" from masonry wall pilasters and corners.

Place and install masonry brick wall ties as described in chapter 21 of the IBC for masonry and stud back up walls.

STRUCTURAL STEEL

Structural steel must be designed, fabricated, and erected according to the specifications of the American Institute of Steel Construction (AISC)

All beams shall be cambered at mid-span as indicated on the structural drawings. No center-point cambering is

Cambers indicated shall be for the beam in the erected position after completion of the end connections and prior to any other dead loads.

Naturally occurring camber in beams to be set with the camber up. Structural steel supplier must supply all cap plates, bearing assemblies, base plates, stiffeners, splices and connections. All welding must match filler materials in accordance with the rules of the American Welding Society (AWS D1.1)

Structural Welding Code. All welders shall be certified by the rules of the American Welding Society. Steel beams to have minimum 5/16" full height web stiffeners each side at all bearing locations and when supporting

columns above. Field weld all steel beams to concrete or masonry bearing plates full length each face with 1/4" fillets. Steel beam lintels to have 3/8" thick bottom plate welded to the bottom flange with 1/4" x 2" fillet welds at 12" OC

each face staggered. Steel lintels to bear on masonry a minimum of 8" each end of the opening. Reinforce the masonry core under the lintel and first adjacent core full height with minimum 1 - #5 vertical reinforcing bar. Grout each core solid. At steel lintels, field weld 5/8" x 24" vertical threaded rod or #5 x 24" weldable rebar to top flange matching vertical reinforcing placement.

All structural steel below grade must be coated with bituminous paint. All structural steel exposed to weather must be galvanized. Modification of structural steel members in the field is not permitted without prior approval by the SER.

STRUCTURAL STEEL CONNECTIONS

Provide standard connections given in parts 7 - 10 of the AISC 360 Steel Construction Manual. Provide certified calculations for non-standard connections by a qualified Professional Engineer who is licensed in the state where the

Typically provide bolted connections for field installation and welded or bolted shop connections. Typical bolts are 3/4" diameter A325-N bolts in standard or short slotted holes. Structural steel supplier must provide all components for OSHA requirements.

DIMENSION LUMBER

Design assumes lumber is free of significant splits and checks. Contractor must visually inspect lumber during installation

All lumber must be grade stamped and provide the following information: grading agency, mill number or name, grade of lumber, species or species grouping or combination designation, rules under which graded, where applicable, All substitute products for use as structural wood screws must be submitted to the SER for approval. and condition of seasoning at time of manufacture. Lumber grading rules and wood species must conform to Voluntary Product Standard PS 20-10 as published by the Department of Commerce. Grading rules must be from an agency certified by the Board of Review of the American

All lumber must be seasoned to a moisture content of 19% or less, with the indication of "S-Dry" on the grade stamp. All lumber must be protected from the elements.

Sill plates and all other lumber in contact with concrete or masonry and within 8" of finished grade must be preservative treated wood. In crawlspaces or unexcavated areas within the building foundation, wood must be preservative treated for joists within 18" of exposed ground and/or girders within 12" of exposed ground. Preservative treated wood must be in accordance with the American Wood Protection Association, Standard U1.

All fasteners and hangers in contact with treated lumber must be G185 hot dipped galvanized or equal. Sill plates to be bolted to foundation wall with 5/8" diameter anchor bolts at 4'-0" OC maximum. Attach each sill plate with a minimum of 2 bolts with one bolt located not more than 12" or less than 4 1/2" from each end of the plate section. Use 1/8" x 2" washers, slightly crushing plate.

All walls must have a single bottom plate and double top plate. At typical openings, provide a minimum of 2 bearing (trimmer or jack) studs and 1 full-height king stud. For headers not noted, provide 2-2x6 up to 4'-0" span and 2-2x8 from 4'-0" to 6'-0" span. Beams and headers must be fully supported across the width of the member. Bear each end on all support studs or

columns noted on plan with a minimum 3" bearing length. Beams or headers made of multiple 2x plies with 1/2" spacer must be nailed together with 16d nails (.162" x 3 1/2") at 16" OC along each edge, typical for each lumber ply. Wood joists must bear the full width of supporting members (stud wall, beams, etc.)

Provide solid vertical blocking at all joist spaces below wood columns. Provide matching columns to foundation at lower levels below columns comprised of 3 or more studs. Beams and joists not bearing on supporting members must be framed with prefabricated metal hangers.

Space joist bridging at a maximum of 8'-0" OC. Double all joists under parallel partitions.

Minimum nailing to be in accordance with Table 2304.9.1 of IBC. All plywood and OSB must be installed per APA standards, including the use of construction adhesive for fastening to floor joists.

Performance requirements, adhesive bond performance, panel construction, workmanship, dimensions, tolerances, marking, and moisture content of Wood-based Structural-use Panels must conform to Voluntary Product Standard PS

2-10 published by the Department of Commerce. **ENGINEERED LUMBER**

All engineered LVL, LSL, and PSL lumber must meet the minimum design properties listed in the Material Strengths

section of these notes. Protect engineered lumber from the elements.

All engineered lumber intended for exterior use must be PSL lumber with Wolmanized preservative protection and meet the minimum design properties as listed in the Material Strengths section of these notes. All fasteners and hangers in contact with treated engineered lumber must be G185 hot dipped galvanized or equal. Engineered lumber headers and beams must have a minimum 3" length of bearing at each end and be supported fully across their width. Fasten LVL beam or header plies together with 2 rows of TrussLOK or SDW screws spaced at 24" OC staggered.

TrussLOK or SDW screws must be 3 3/8" long for 2-ply members, 5" long for 3-ply members, and 6 3/4" long for 4-ply.

Fasten PSL or LSL beam or header plies together per manufacturer recommendations. Provide solid vertical blocking at all joist spaces below engineered lumber columns. Provide matching columns to foundation at lower levels below engineered lumber columns. Engineered lumber beams and joists not bearing on supporting members must be framed with prefabricated metal hangers.

WOOD TRUSSES

Responsibilities of the contractor, building designer, truss manufacturer, and truss designer must follow the publication "TPI 1-2007 National Design Standard for Metal Plate Connected Wood Truss Construction.'

Truss supplier shall notify SER of any proposed revisions to the layout indicated on this plan. Revisions that affect the structural design will not be allowed without prior approval of the SER. Verify allowable bearing locations for girder trusses with SER prior to final design stage. Provide metal bearing enhancers as necessary to utilize

stud columns shown on plan. All prefabricated wood trusses must be furnished in accordance with designs prepared by a Professional Engineer licensed in the state in which

the project is located, using the design loads and span conditions indicated, including designing gable end truss webs for perpendicular to face

Truss manufacturer shall submit a truss layout, certified truss drawings, and certified calculations prior to beginning construction. Trusses must be designed for the superimposed dead and live loads as indicated in the Design Loads section of these notes. Truss supplier shall design trusses to support additional dead load from, but not limited to; roof top mechanical units, sprinkler lines, rain leader systems, piping, cable trays, ductwork, and similar items. Contractor to coordinate with architectural, mechanical, and electrical requirements.

Contractor to provide location and magnitude of all such loads to truss supplier and SER prior to preparation of shop drawings. See architectural plans for attic draft stop locations and design roof trusses accordingly.

Live load deflection of roof trusses must be limited to 1/240 of the span. See plans and details for specific requirements adjacent to parallel walls.

Design trusses for top chord bearing or bottom chord bearing as shown on drawings.

Truss configuration, pitch, overhang, etc. must be indicated as noted on the architectural drawings. Spacing of roof trusses must not exceed 24" OC

Lumber for wood trusses must be in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Provide metal framing anchors at roof truss bearing to mechanically fasten truss to bearing wall or supporting member as shown in details. Truss manufacturer shall provide truss to truss connection hangers.

No cutting, notching, or modifications of trusses will be allowed without the manufacturer's written approval. Locations of bridging and bracing at truss compression and tension members must be indicated by the truss manufacturer. Contractor shall provide permanent and temporary diagonal, lateral, and cross bracing in accordance with the publication "BCSI 1-06 Building Component Safety Information, Guide to Good Practice for Handling, Installing and Bracing of Metal Plate Connected Wood Trusses" by the Truss Plate Institute and Wood Truss Council of America and as otherwise necessary.

Wood panel wall sheathing must be minimum 1/2" nominal (15/32") thick panels rated per APA for the spacing of the supporting members. A minimum 32/16 span rating is recommended.

Fasten wood panel wall sheathing with 8d nails (.131" diameter x 2 1/2") spaced at 6" OC at supported edges and 12" OC at intermediate supports. Leave an 1/8" gap at all end and edge joints to allow for expansion. Stagger end joints of panels. Panels must be continuous over two or more spans and the long panel dimension may be either perpendicular or parallel to supports.

All edges must be blocked. Refer to plan and notes for any special shear wall nailing and bolting conditions.

Provide Exterior or Exposure 1 grade.

Floor sheathing must be minimum 3/4" nominal (23/32") thick tongue and groove panels rated per APA for the spacing of the supporting members. A minimum 48/24 span rating is recommended.

Provide Exposure 1 grade. Panels must be continuous over two or more spans and the long panel dimension must be perpendicular to supports. Fasten sheathing with construction adhesive and 10d nails (.148" diameter x 3") spaced at 6" OC at supported edges and 6" OC at intermediate

ROOF SHEATHING

Roof sheathing must be minimum 5/8" nominal (19/32") thick panels rated per APA for the spacing of the supporting members. A minimum 40/20 span rating is recommended. Provide panel clips, one between each support, for supports spaced greater than 16" OC. Provide Exterior or Exposure 1 grade.

Panels must be continuous over two or more spans and the long panel dimension must be perpendicular to supports. Fasten roof sheathing with 10d nails (.148" diameter x 3") spaced at 6" OC at supported edges and 12" OC at intermediate supports. Leave an 1/8" gap at all end and edge joints to allow for expansion.

STRUCTURAL WOOD CONNECTORS

Prefabricated steel connectors noted on drawings refer to Simpson Strong-Tie hangers, clips, post bases, hold downs, etc. with specified product USP connectors may be submitted as a substitution to the SER for approval.

All prefabricated metal connectors must be installed in strict accordance with the manufacturer's recommendation.

Structural Wood Screws (SWS) noted in the drawings refer to high-strength, self-tapping wood screws. The table below defines SWS by diameter with a list of acceptable manufacturer products. The following criteria apply:

Minimum Yield Strength: 160,000 psi (carbon steel) Conforms to ASTM A510 and/or has values published by third-party testing such as ICC Powder-coated or otherwise treated for corrosion protection. Acceptable products by Size (length varies per manufacturer)

Design of roof sheathing assumes that the roof will be properly insulated and ventilated.

Refer to APA publication N335N "Proper Installation of APA Rated Sheathing for Roof Applications."

STRUCTURAL INSULATED PANELS (SIPS)

SIPS must be designed, fabricated, and erected to meet or exceed the Structural Insulated Panel Association (SIPA) standard details. SIPS panel sizes must be as shown on the plans.

SIPS panels at the roof and walls, including attachments, must be designed by the manufacturer to support the loads shown in the Design Loads section of these notes, wind shear (racking), and building stability. Provide test result data for standard panels and connections. Provide certified calculations for non-standard conditions by a qualified Professional Engineer who is licensed in the state where the project is located. Submit complete shop drawings to architect and SER for approval, showing necessary dimensions, fabrication, installation details, and connection

Sheathing must be minimum 7/16" thick Oriented Strand Board (OSB) panels rated per APA for the spacing of the supporting members. A

minimum 24/16 span rating is recommended. Insulation core must comply with ASTM C578 and have a minimum density of 0.9 pcf. Provide airtight seal at all panel joints, voids, and penetrations according to manufacturer's specifications.

Deflection criteria must conform to the requirements set forth by the IBC. Limit deflection for members supporting brick veneer to a maximum of 1/600 of the span. Modification of SIPS in the field is not permitted without written approval by the supplier.

ADHESIVE/MECHANICAL ANCHORS

SIPS must not be supported directly by concrete.

Adhesive and mechanical anchors must be provided and installed in strict accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and the design

Refer to the special inspections table for inspection requirements. All horizontal and upwardly inclined installations that resist sustained tension loads must be performed by certified adhesive anchor installers. Provide anchor type and size as indicated on the drawings with length identification markings conforming to ICC ES AC01 or ICC ES AC193. Concrete Screw Anchors are a single-use item. Do not remove and reinstall anchors nor install new anchors in previously used holes. For exposed exterior applications, use only adhesive anchoring systems with stainless steel accessories.

The conctractor shall include in the bid the cost of all testing and inspections indicated on the plans and in the specifications, including special inspections required by the building code. The actual contracting of the inspection and testing services shall be in accordance with the division of responsibility dictated by the Minnesota Building Code.

IBC Section 1705 requires that in addition to the inspections required by Section 110, the owner shall employ one or more special inspectors who shall provide inspections during construction of certain
