Describe the end use of the building: The building was designed to be a high end, energy efficient duplex that would provide comfort and healthy living for whoever bought it. With radiant in floor heat and Dettson mini duct furnaces, these duplex's are able to be kept at very comfortable temperatures all year long and cost very little to do it.

How did SIP construction help you get this job? Knowing that we wanted these Duplex's to stand out from the rest in the region SIPs were a no brainer. Since labor in the area is not easy to find we knew that using SIPs would help get this project shelled in and ready for the next sub to come in very quickly. We used 4' treated SIP frost footings and 6 1/2" and 4 1/2" walls from Extreme Panel Technologies. All of the panels were put up for this building in 3 days with only 3-4 guys working! Using the 4 1/2" wall for the demising wall combined with a tested assembly achieved a high STC rating so noise can not be heard from one side to the other.

SIP wall thickness and core material: 6 5/8" frost footings 6 1/2" Exterior house and garage and 4 1/2" for demising wall between units all using EPS foam SIP roof thickness and core material: n/a

Describe the benefits of using SIPs on this project. Did SIPs help save time, labor, construction costs, or energy? The two major benefits to using SIPs on this project were the energy efficiency they give and the labor/construction cost they save. We were able to have the frost footings in and pour the floor right away not having to wait for concrete frost footings to cure. The exterior walls for the duplex went up in just over a day which allowed our interior walls to get framed and our electricians to start running wires in just a matter of days.

Describe any innovative design elements or structural engineering involved: This was our first time using the Dettson mini duct furnace. This furnace has a main 6" trunk line coming off of it which allowed it to be kept in a conditioned space. Off of the main trunk there are 2" lines that feed to all of the rooms to distribute the conditioned air. The Dettson will supply supplemental heat in the fall before boilers are started and will also be the A/C for the houses. It runs off of one air source heat pump located at the exterior of the house. One innovative design of the Dettson is that if the temperature outside is below 30 degrees F it will switch from the air source heat pump to gas all by itself to run more efficiently. All of the lighting in the house is LED which combined with the natural light from the energy efficient Marvin Ultrex windows gives a warm cozy feeling inside of the homes.
