SITework: THE SITE SHALL BE GRADED TO PROVIDE DRAINAGE AWAY FROM THE BUILDING. SLOPE AWAY FROM WALL ½" PER FOOT MIN. 6' FROM WALL.

CONCRETE WORK: THE CONCRETE WORK SHALL CONSIST OF ALL NECESSARY POUR-IN-PLACE CONCRETE FOOTINGS (OR FOUNDATION) AS PER BUILDING PLANS DESIGNED BY OTHERS THE CONCRETE SHALL MEET A MINIMUM COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH OF 3,500 PSI AT 28 DAYS. ALL CONCRETE SHALL BE DESIGNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMERICAN CONCRETE INSTITUTE BUILDING CODE REQUIREMENTS FOR STRUCTURAL CONCRETE (ACI 318-05) AND COMMENTARY (ACI 318R-05).

WOOD FRAMING: ALL WOOD CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE 2005 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL DESIGN SPECIFICATION FOR WOOD CONSTRUCTION. UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE ALL FRAMING LUMBER SHALL BE SPF#2 GRADE.

TRUSSES: WOOD TRUSSES ARE SHOP/PLANT FABRICATED WITH CONNECTOR PLATES PER SPECIFICATIONS. DESIGN CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE TRUSS PLATE INSTITUTE - (ANSI/TPI 1-2007). REFER TO THE BCSI(BUILDING COMPONENT SAFETY INFORMATION) MANUAL FOR WOOD TRUSS TEMPORARY BRACING REQUIREMENTS.

METAL CONNECTORS: ALL METAL CONNECTORS ARE OF GALVANIZED STEEL AND DESIGN APPROVED TO MEET OR EXCEED REQUIRED STANDARDS.

ROOFING AND SIDING MATERIAL: THE METAL ROOF AND WALLS SHALL BE EPS FULL FORMED PANEL. THE RIBBED DESIGN HAS ¾" HIGH PRIMARY RIBS 9" O.C. FOR BEAM STRENGTH AND 2 INTERMEDIATE LOW RIBS 3" O.C. FOR ADDITIONAL STIFFENING. THE EPS ROLL FORM PANEL IS MANUFACTURED TO ASTM SPECS. W/ AN 80,000 PSI MIN. YIELD POINT AND AN 82,000 PSI MINIMUM TENSILE STRENGTH. A FOUR-LAYER COLOR-CLAD PROCESS INCLUDES MIN G-60 GALVANIZED ZINC COATING, BONDERIZED COATING, BAKED ON PRIMER COATING, AND A SILICONIZED POLYESTER(WHITE IS POLYESTER ONLY) BAKED-ON PAINT FINISH.

FASTENERS: ALL ROOF AND WALL METAL SHEATHING SHALL BE FASTENED TO THE BUILDING STRUCTURE W/ TRUE-GRIP SCREWS W/ MILL POINT AND HEX HEAD. THE SCREWS SHALL HAVE A EPDM RUBBER WASHER TO ENSURE WEATHER TIGHTNESS.

SHORING AND BRACING: CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL TEMPORARY SHORING AND BRACING.

* THIS SET OF PLANS ARE INTENDED TO BE USED BY CONTRACTORS WITH BUILDING CONSTRUCTION KNOWLEDGE.

STEEL PANELS ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE BUILDING STRUCTURE AND ANY FUTURE FIELD MODIFICATIONS MADE MAY BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE BUILDING'S STRUCTURAL PERFORMANCE.

*IF THE ENVIRONMENT THE ENGINEERED WOOD TRUSSES ARE TO BE PLACED WITHIN THIS STRUCTURES HAS THE POTENTIAL TO BE HIGH MOISTURE AND CORROSIVE ATMOSPHERE IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED TO USE ADDITIONAL PROTECTION FOR THE TRUSS GUSSET PLATES. PLEASE REFER TO SECTION 9.2.2.2 OF ANSI/TPI-1995 FOR DETAILS OF ADDITIONAL PROTECTION. IN ADDITION THE STRUCTURAL WOOD MEMBERS SHOULD NOT BE SUBJECT TO AIR MOISTURE LEVELS SUCH THAT THE MOISTURE CONTENT OF THE WOOD MEMBERS EXCEEDS 16%.

* THE CEILING SYSTEM PROVIDED HAS NOT BEEN DESIGNED FOR HUMAN TRAFFIC. CONTRACTORS - IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO WARN OTHER TRADES.

* TO MINIMIZE THE POSSIBILITY OF FASTENER POPPING AND CRACKING IN AREAS ADJACENT TO A WALL AND CEILING INTERSECTION, A FLOATING GYPSUM CORNER ANGLE METHOD OF APPLICATION SHOULD BE USED. PLEASE REFER TO THE GYPSUM ASSOCIATION'S SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE APPLICATION AND FINISHING OF GYPSUM PANEL PRODUCTS.

* THERE MAY BE SOME "BOWING" OF EXTERIOR STRUCTURAL INSULATED PANELS DUE TO A TEMPERATURE AND MOISTURE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR OSB SKINS. WHEN THE EXTERIOR SKIN EXPERIENCES COLD TEMPERATURE, ITS MOISTURE CONTENT RISES, WHICH CAUSES THE EXTERIOR SKIN TO EXPAND. THIS MAY CAUSE THE PANEL TO BOW OUT. TO MINIMIZE THE EFFECT, YOU MAY WANT TO CONSIDER:
A.) HIDE THE "BOW" BY USING FLOATING CORNERS ON THE INTERIOR GYPSUM BOARD.
B.) MECHANICALLY FASTENING ONE STRUCTURAL INSULATED PANEL TO THE CROSS WALLS. THE CROSS WALL WILL HAVE TO BE DESIGNED TO RESIST FORCES OF THE BOW, AS WILL THE MECHANICAL FASTENERS.

* THE INTERIOR OF THIS STRUCTURE IS SEPARATED FROM THE FOAM PLASTIC INSULATION WITH A MINIMUM ¾" THICK MATERIAL. TESTED PER ASTM METHOD E119-98 FIRE TESTS OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIALS FOR A MINIMUM 15 MINUTE THERMAL BARRIER REQUIRED

NOTE: WHEN APPLYING ICE & WATER OR "PEEL & SEAL" FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS TO PREVENT AIR INFILTRATION
1. BE SURE TEMERATURE OF MATERIALS AND AMBIENT TEMPERATURE ARE BOTH ABOVE 50° F.
2. THOROUGHLY CLEAN SURFACES.
3. APPLY ACETONE(BY OTHERS) TO METAL SURFACE TO CLEAN.
4. ALLOW ACETONE TO FLASH OFF.
5. APPLY "PEEL & SEAL" OR ICE & WATER. BE SURE TO APPLY PRESSURE THROUGH OUT MATERIAL TO ENSURE 100% CONTACT.

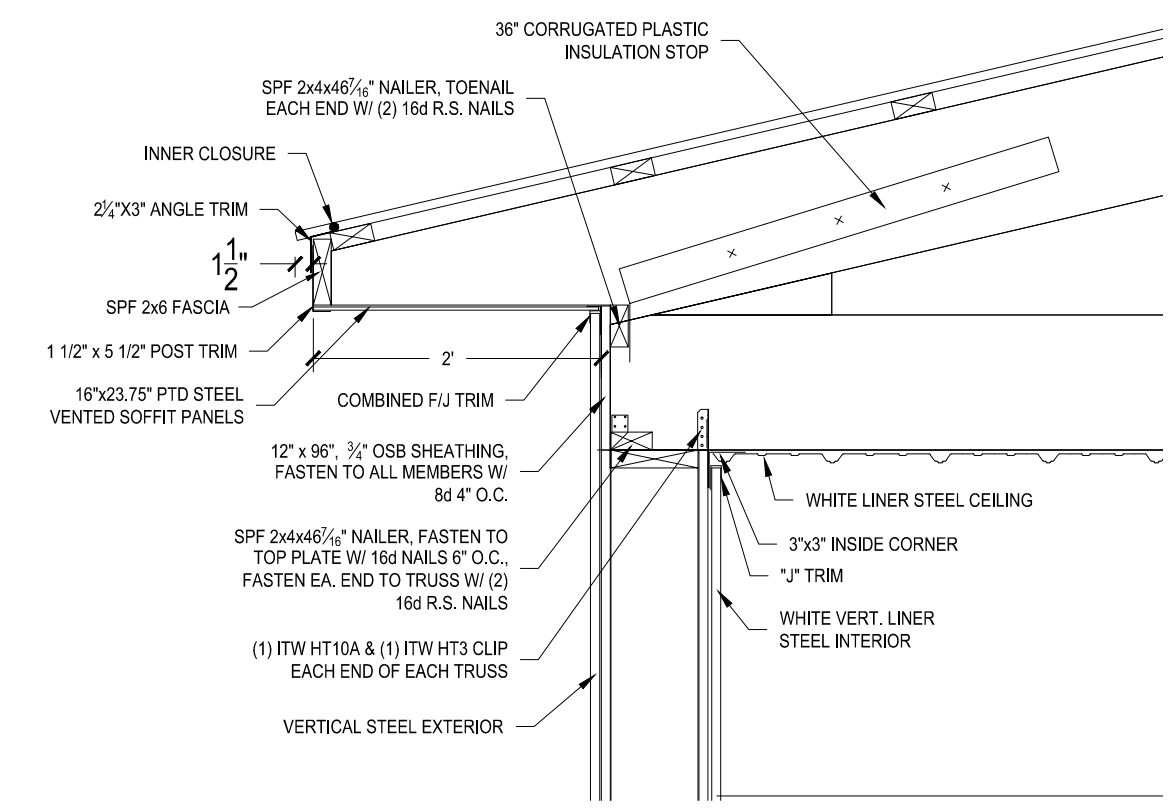
2 ENDWALL SECTION

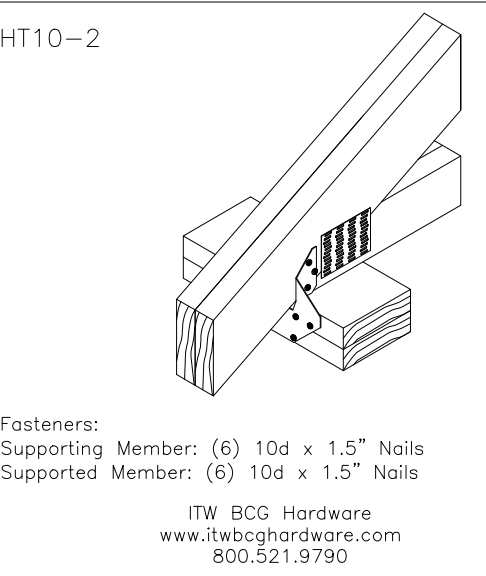
4 PORCH SECTION

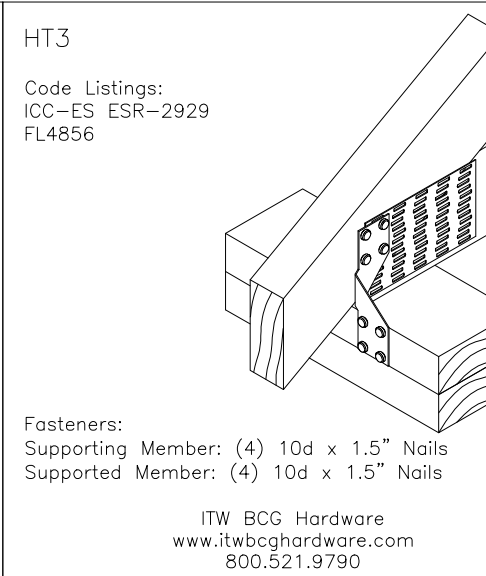
3 PORCH HEADER/EAVE/WALL DETAIL

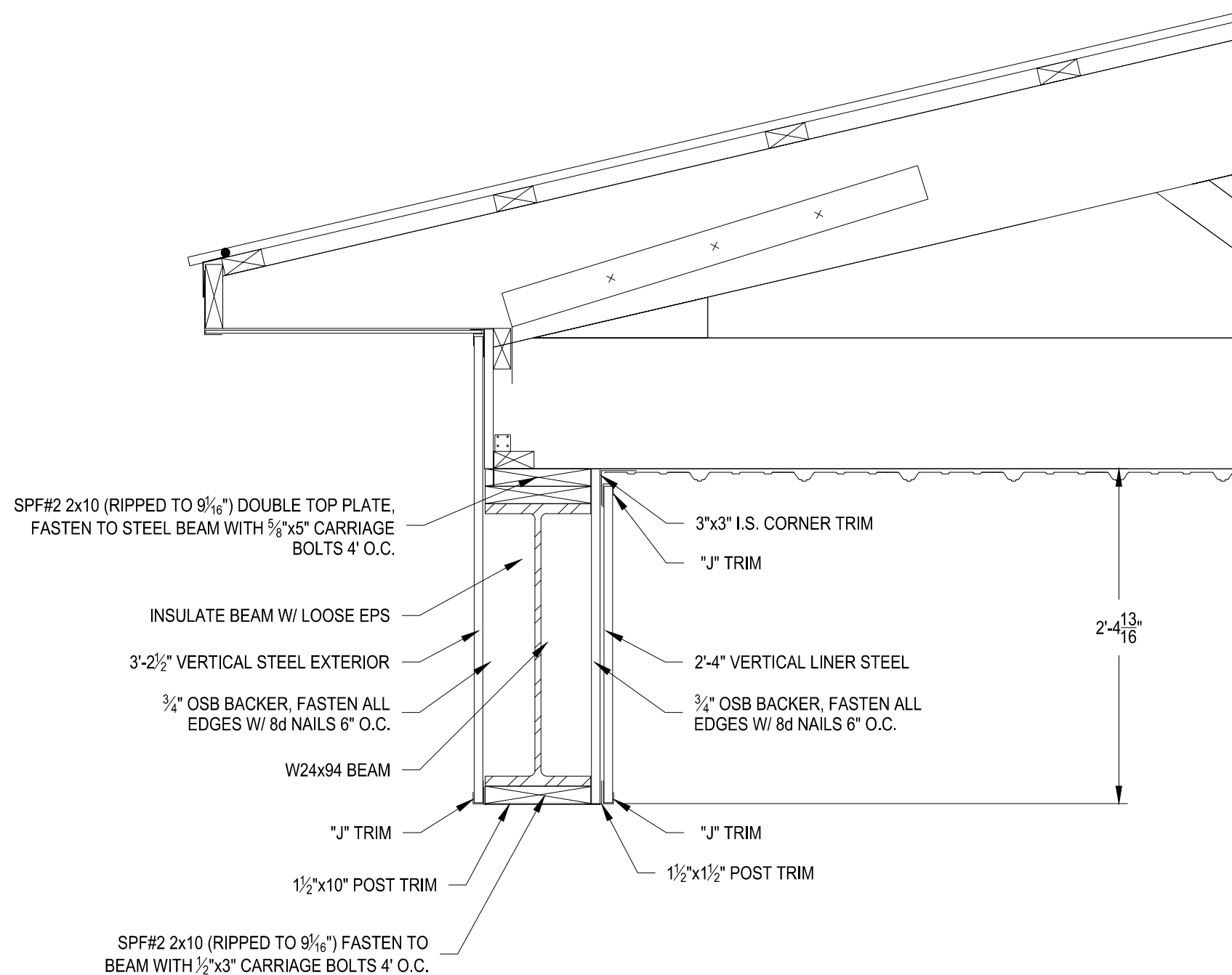
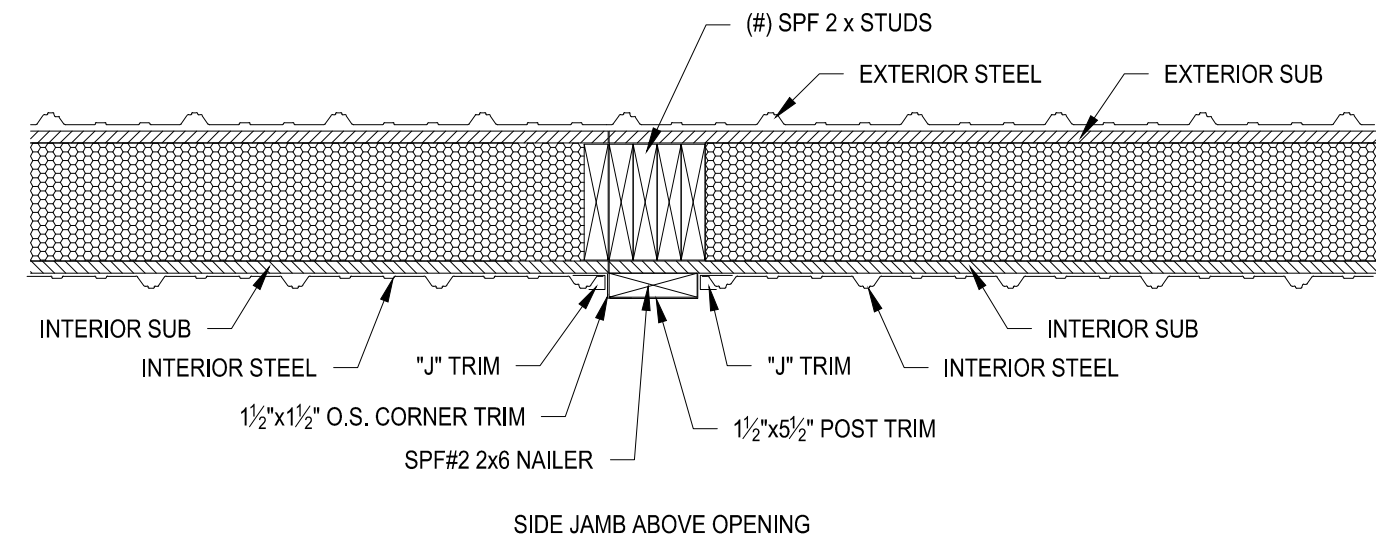
1 WALK DOOR JAMB

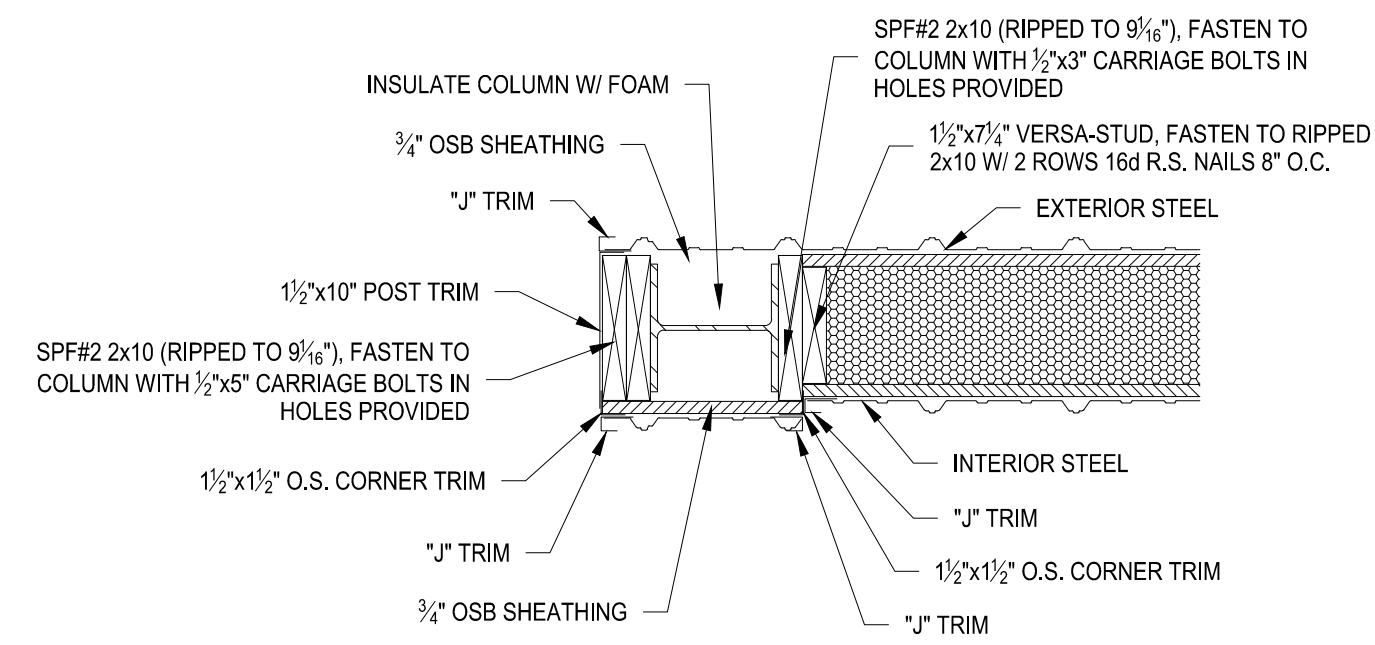
2 WINDOW JAMB

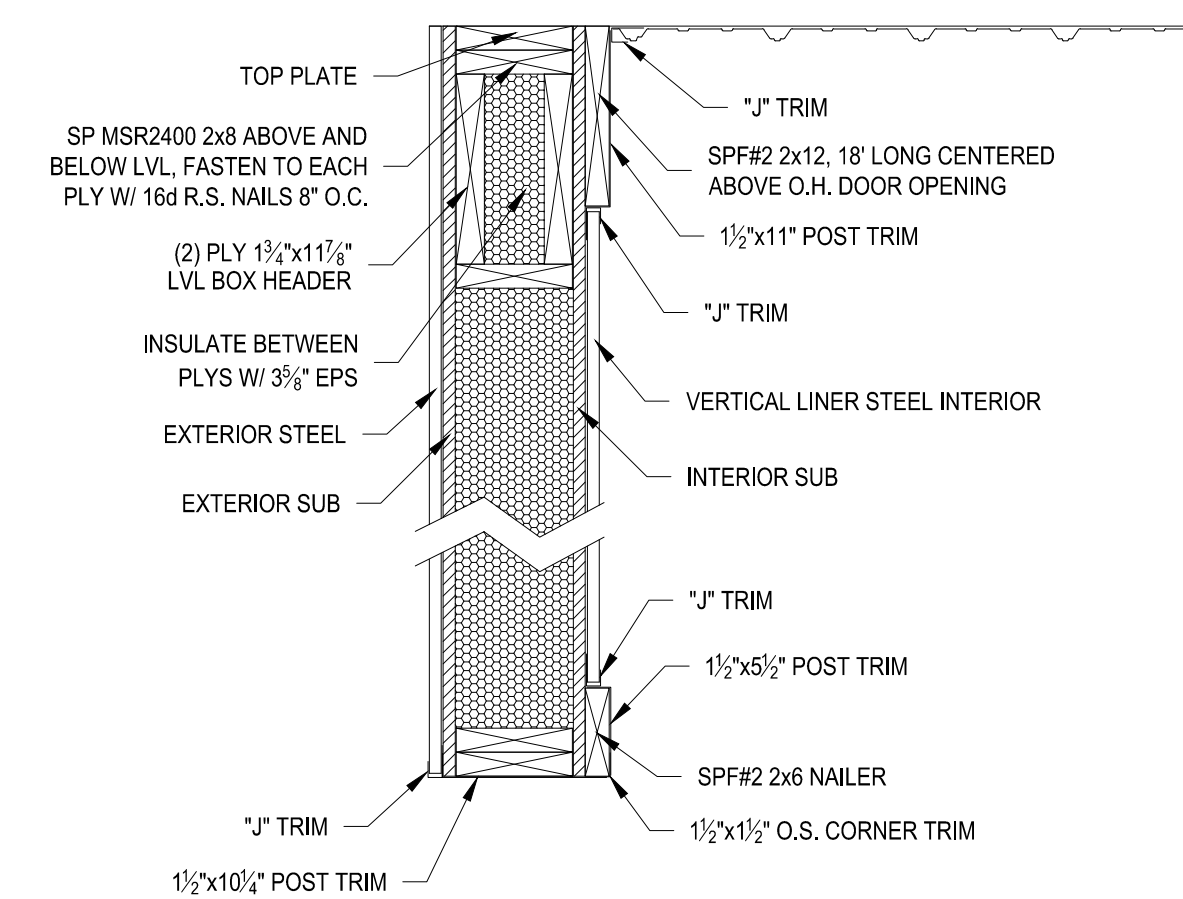
3 OVERHEAD DOOR SIDE JAMB

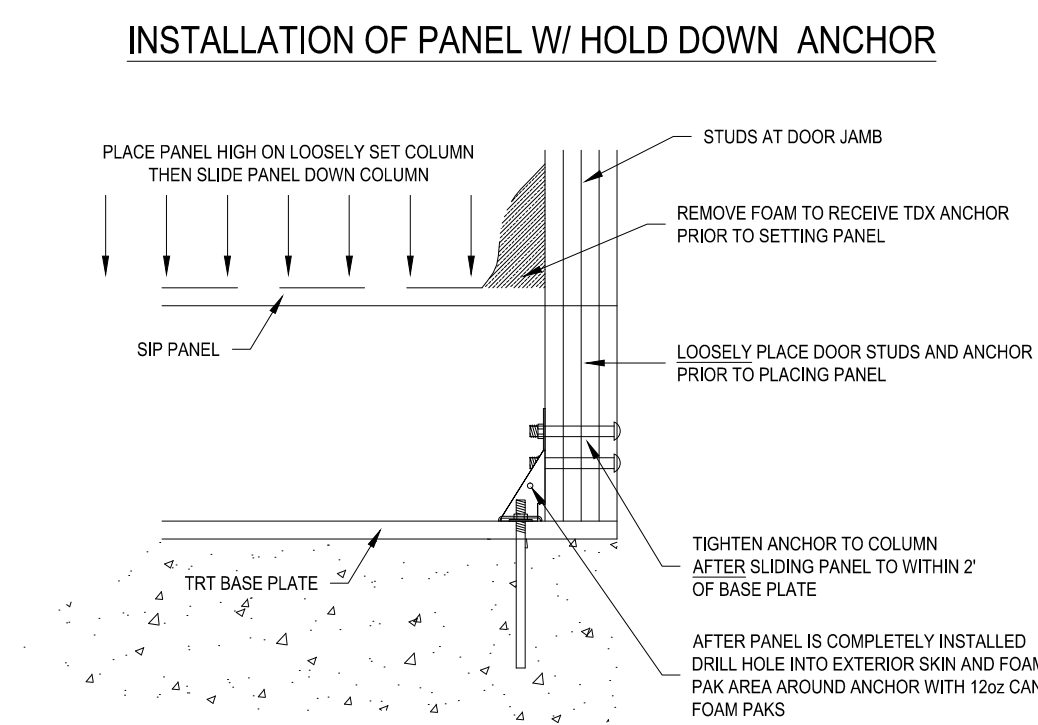
5 HYDRAULIC DOOR HEADER DETAIL

GENERAL LAYOUT NOTES:

1. Complete truss engineering and analysis can be found on the Truss Design Drawings which may be sealed by the Truss Design Engineer as applicable. The trusses identified are designed as individual building components to be incorporated into the building to support the loads specified on the individual truss drawings. The Contractor/owner is to verify that no other load, from the overall building system, is imposed on these trusses.

2. Any discrepancies between the dimensions and conditions specified on this layout versus the approved for construction prints should be reported prior to truss fabrication.

3. Never exceed the design loading shown and never stack materials on inadequately braced trusses.

4. Do NOT cut or alter truss location without prior approval of Energy Panel Structures. All connections must be made in such a way as to prevent splitting. Pre-drill if necessary.

5. Design assumes trusses will be suitably protected from the environment in accord with ANSI/TP1 2007.

6. The required permanent bracing for the truss top chord, bottom chord, and webs are specified on the individual truss drawing. See EPS drawings for requirements.

7. For general guidance regarding bracing consult BCSI Guide to good practice for handling, installing, and bracing of metal plate connected wood trusses" available from the Truss Plate Institute, 218 North Lee St., Ste. 312, Alexandria, VA 22314 - (703) 683-1010 - www.tpinst.org

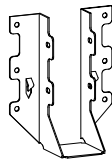
2. Until the building is completely erected in accordance with the construction documents, the trusses are unstable and may present a safety hazard. Truss instability may increase with building width, height, and length.

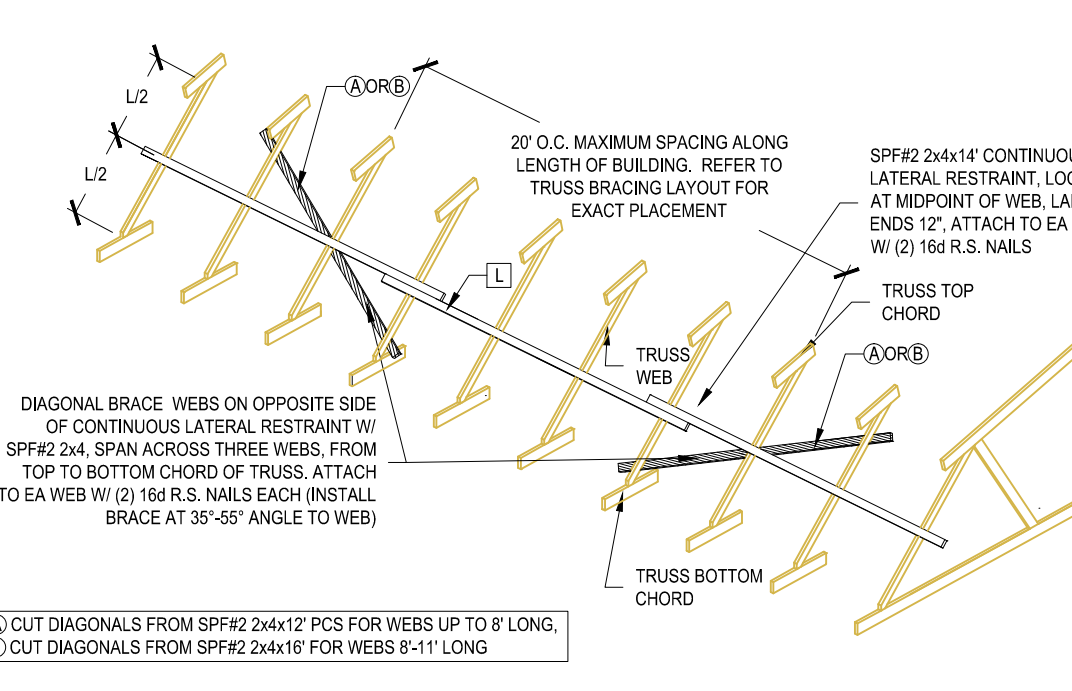

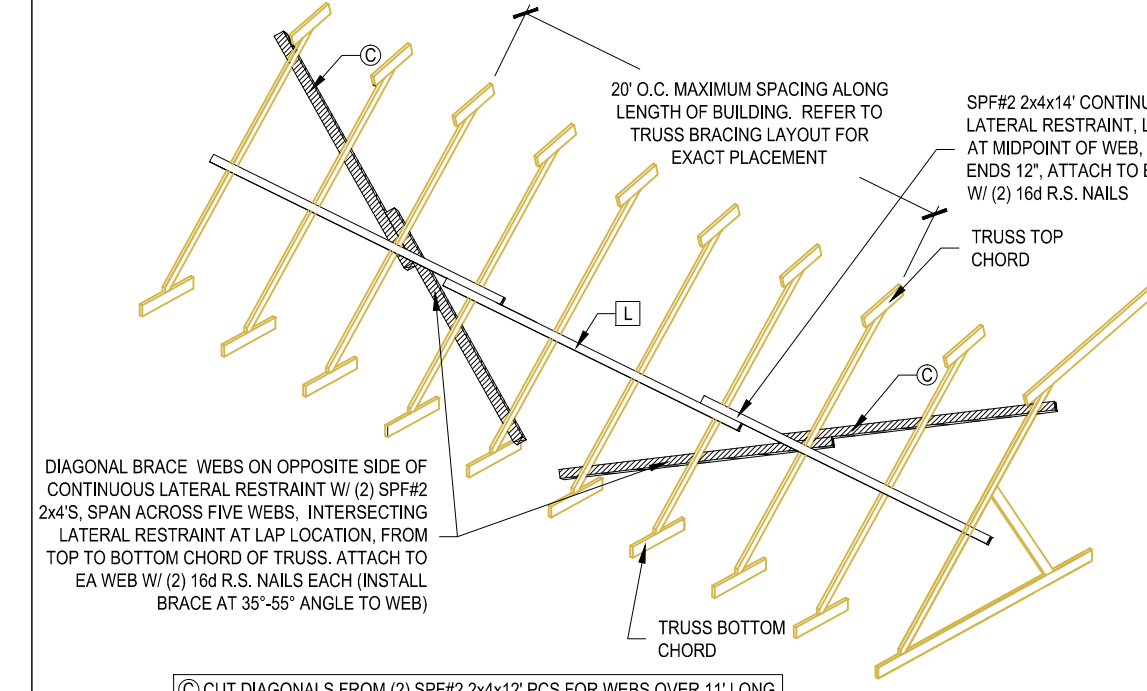

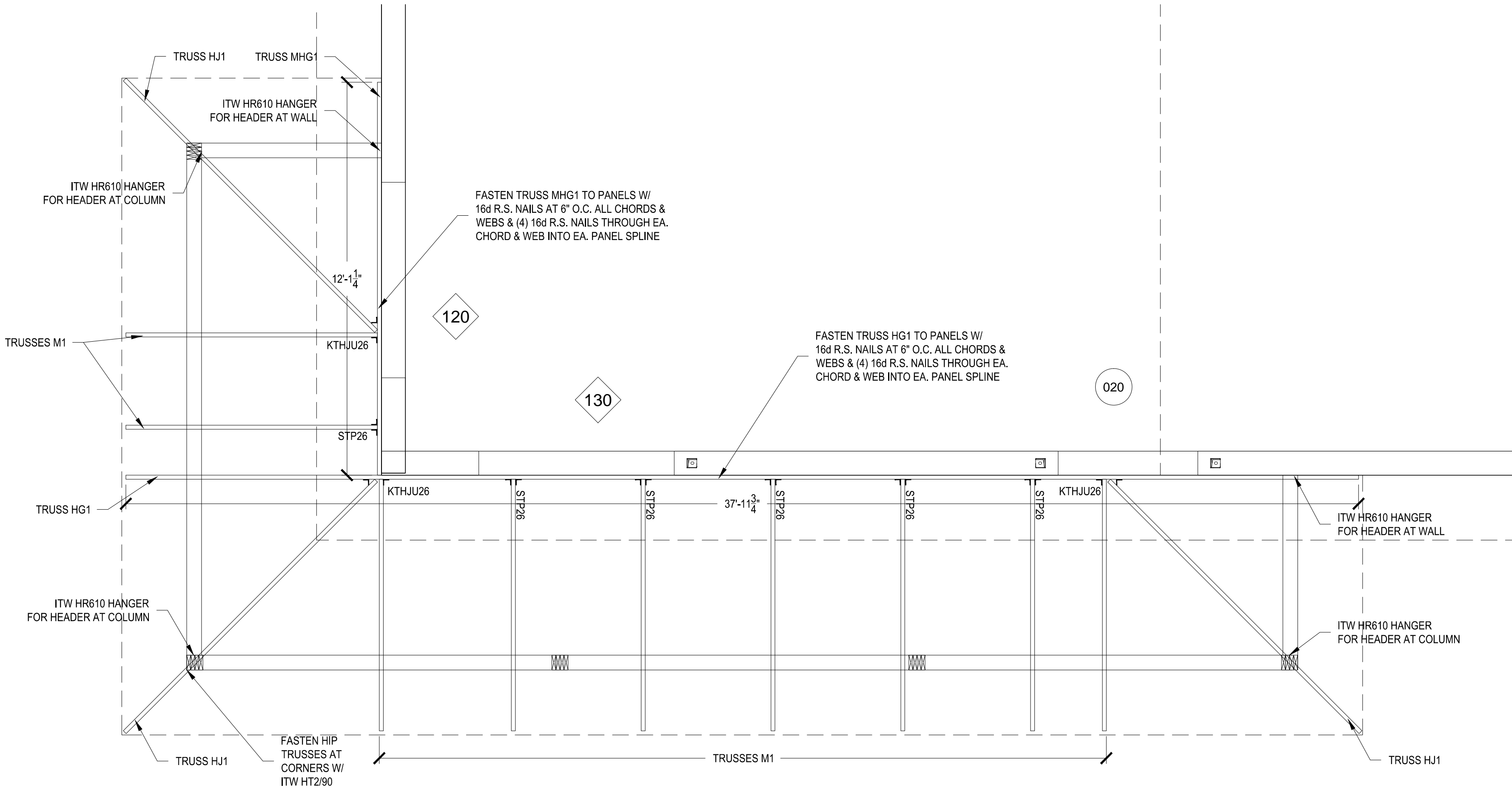

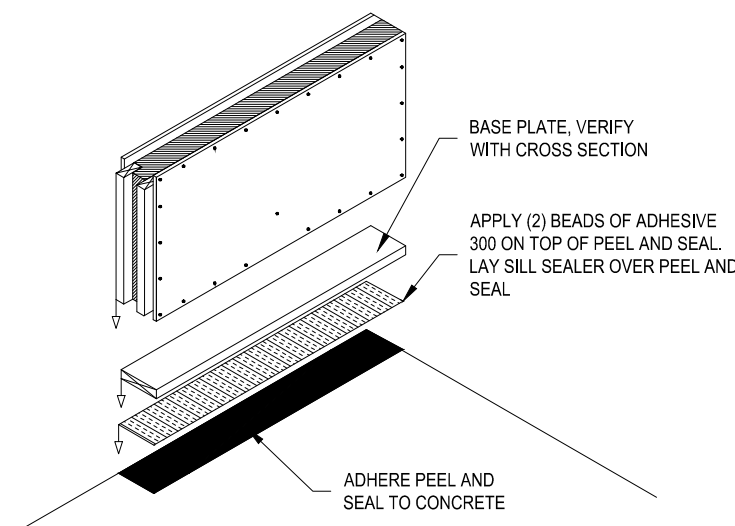

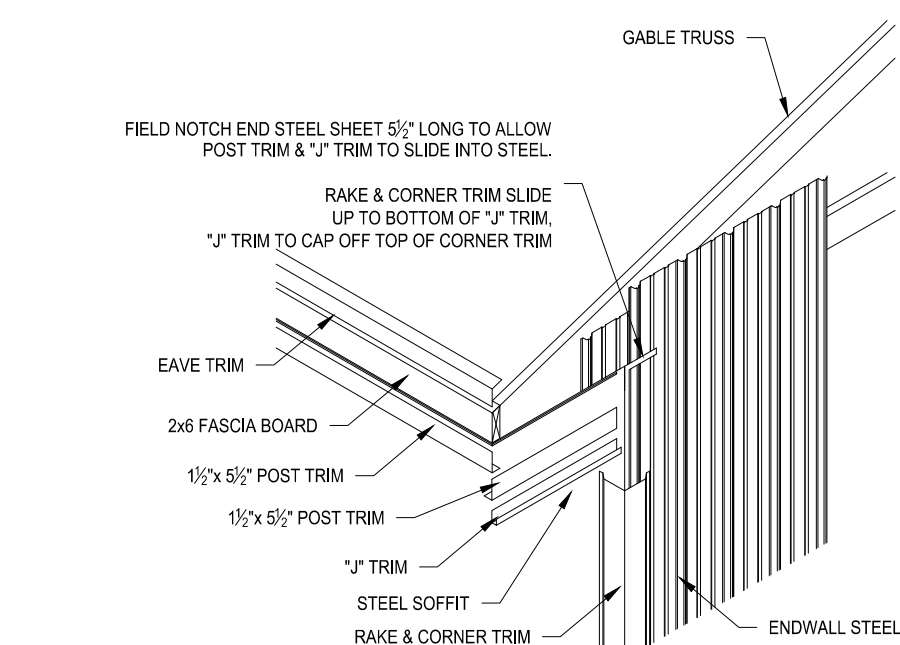

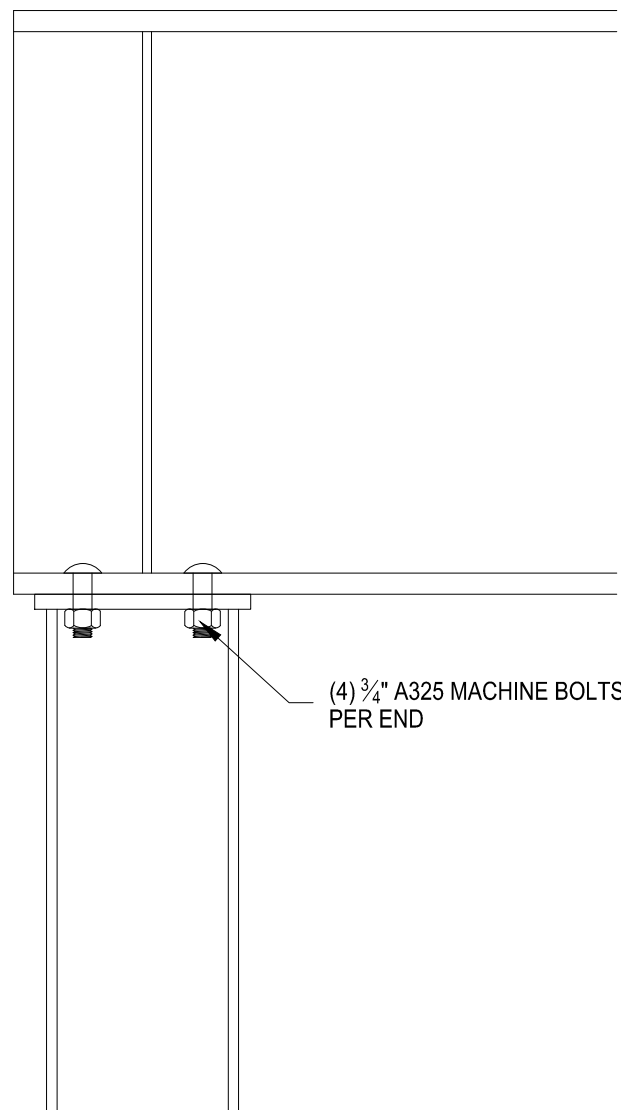

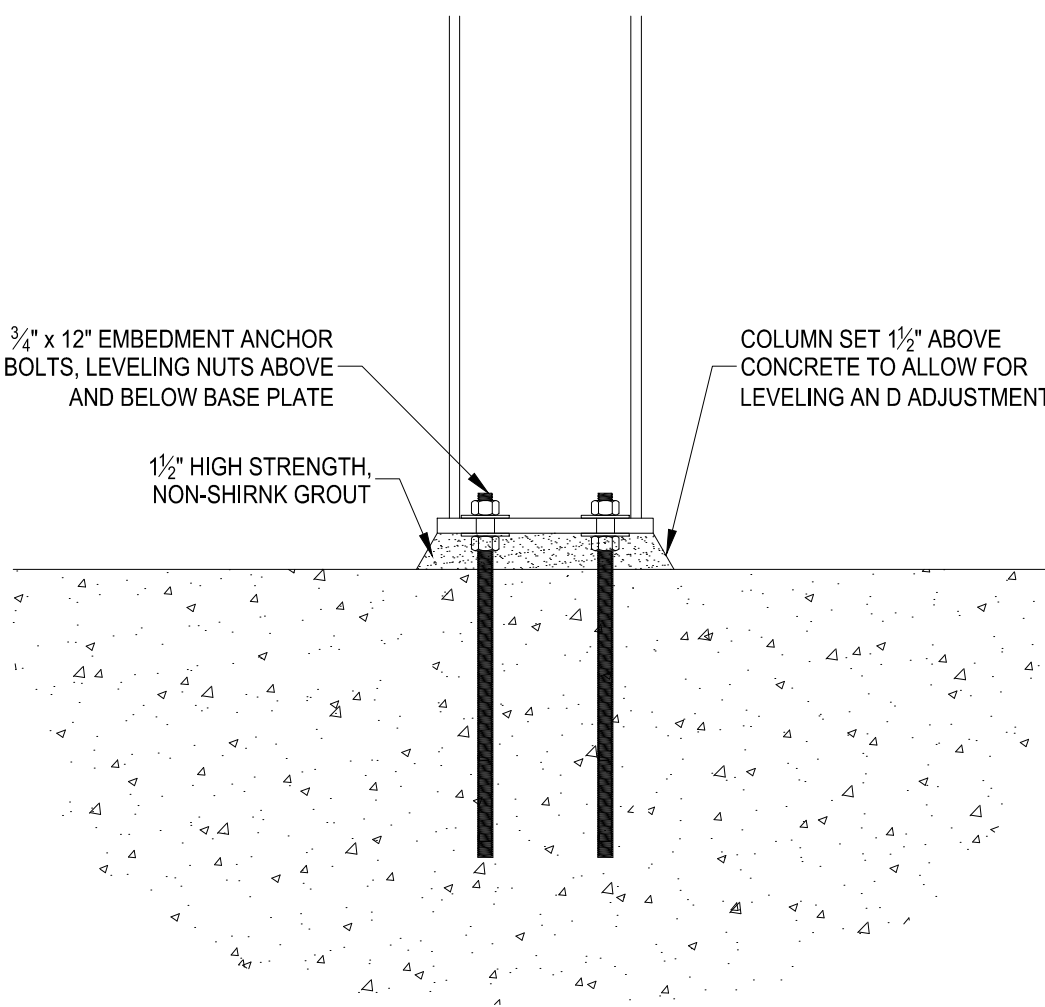
