The lot that this home was built upon had setbacks of 5 feet along each side of the house to the property line. SIPs allowed for the home to be constructed in fewer steps and in a more "neighbor-friendly" manner. Additionally, the ability to erect a structure and immediately be adde to heat it during the winter for subcontracters to work on the Muchanics of the huse, is a great asset of the SIP construction.

Describe any innovative design elements or structural engineering involved:

The second stony of the home is an engineered in-room truss with four separate duriners. Several girder fousses were upwards of 1,000 punds to carry the load of the upper level ridge beams. These allowed for a completely vaulted second story lounge with 13 foot ceilings. The roof engineering and thus work is second to none!
